## ARE YOUR SHEEP FIT TO TRAVEL?

UK law requires that all animals must be fit for the intended journey and not transported in a way likely to cause injury or undue suffering

## Have you checked for...



- Any open wounds, flystrike or prolapses
  - Disease
  - e.g. Scab, black bag, pasteurella
- Visual impairment
- Weakness, fatigue or poor body condition
- Lameness
  - Physical abnormalities
- e.g. Joint ill, suspected fractures
- Late stage pregnancy
- Ingrowing horns

## We all have a responsibility to ensure animals are fit for their intended journey.

By law: in cases of doubt, you must seek advice from your veterinary surgeon and consider alternatives including treatment or on-farm slaughter.
