ECSRHM residency at the RVC & Synergy Farm Health

In collaboration with Synergy Farm Health, the RVC has recently received approval as a training centre for residents of the European College of Small Ruminant Health Management. Residents will gain extensive practical clinical experience working with the team at Synergy. The practice has a large and established small ruminant caseload with both flock and individual animal work and an active team of seven clinicians focused on commercially focused, evidence based medicine. There will also be significant involvement in undergraduate and farmer training, as well as research.

Residents will be under the supervision of ECSRHM diplomats at both Synergy and the RVC.
